Who Is Eligible?

Home Health Care may be considered for homebound patients who are recovering from an illness or injury, undergoing treatment, disabled or chronically ill, or in need of post-surgical care. It is typically covered under Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurances.

Hospice Care is covered 100% by Medicare, Medicaid, and many insurance policies. There are many diagnoses that qualify for hospice care including: heart disease, dementia, renal disease, cancer, and general debility. There is no limit to the time a patient can remain on hospice, provided they meet eligibility criteria.

Patient Services are provided without regard to race, color, creed, age, gender, sexual orientation, handicap (mental or physical), or place of national origin.
